This net meets each Tuesday evening at 8:00PM on the 442.925 MHz repeater, (tone of 141.3)

Your Net Control Station this evening is (*Your Call*) and my name is (*Your Name*)

The purpose of this Net is to train operators in traffic net procedures and to provide a meeting place for NCRG members.

All amateur radio operators, within the range of this repeater, are welcome and encouraged to participate in the Net, with or without comments.

At this time, are there any stations on frequency with Emergency, Priority, or Welfare traffic.

(*Pause*)

At this time, are there any stations on frequency with routine traffic for the net.

(*Pause*)

At this time, are there any stations on frequency with announcements or bulletins for the net.

(*Pause*)

We will now take check-ins to the net. Check-in procedure is as follows;

Key your radio and say .. *THIS IS* ... un-key and listen to insure that you have accessed the repeater and that you are not doubling with another station. Key your radio and identify your station with your call-sign and name.

We will now take check-ins to the net ... please come now.

*Record all station calls and names (and cities if you like), recognize stations after things slow a bit. Take more check-ins when convenient. Go thru the list a couple of times. Make last call for check-in. Announce the count. Close the net and return the repeater to normal amateur use. Identify and Clear.*
